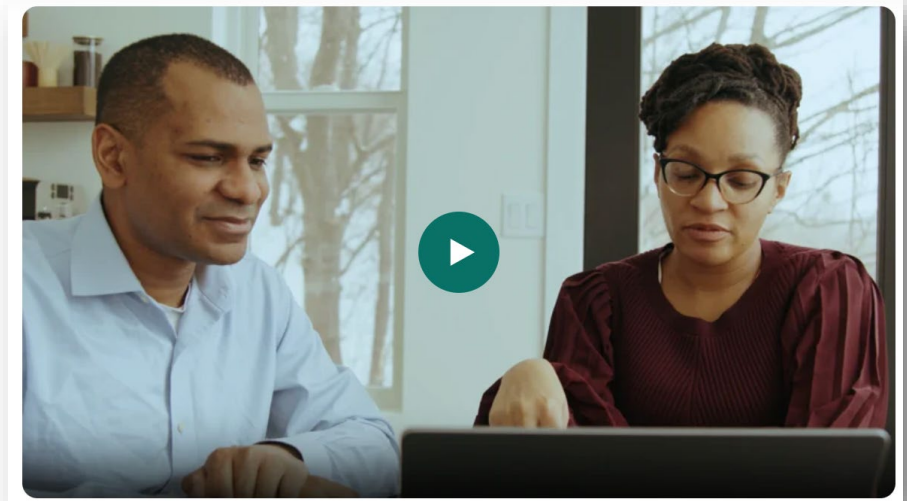

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# Virtual Care through Accolade Care

## HealthSavings+:

- Preventive Care = No cost to the member
- PCP, Urgent Care and Behavioral Health visits = \$30 per visit before deductible
- 30% after deductible is met (\$9)

## UC Care:

- Preventive Care = No cost to the member
- PCP, Urgent Care and Behavioral Health visits = No cost for the first 12 PCP/Urgent or first 12 Behavioral Health (Therapy)
- Visit 13 and beyond, your cost for each medical or mental health visit is \$115

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# What's Changing in 2026

- UC PPO plans administered by Blue Shield of California
- CORE and UC Health Savings Plan (HSP) - Both terminating 12/31/2026
  - » Automatic enrollment in HealthSavings+

# What's Changing in 2026 cont.

- HealthSavings+ is UC's lowest premium medical plan
  - Includes a Health Savings Account (Administered by HealthEquity)
  - UC is increasing the annual HSA contribution
    - » \$750 for individuals
    - » \$1,500 for families

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# What's Changing in 2026 cont.

- 98% Anthem Blue Cross providers remain in-network with Blue Shield of California
- Check the network status of your provider or search for new providers
- Transition of care through March 31, 2026
- Existing prior authorizations will be transferred to BSC and honored into 2026

# What's Changing in 2026 cont.

- Weight loss medications (including GLP-1 medications, such as Zepbound, Wegovy, appetite suppressants, etc.)
  - New criteria: Require pre-treatment BMI of 40 or higher as part of the prior authorization process
  - PPO Members currently on weight loss medication **may** continue treatment **if** the members have pre-treatment BMI of 40 or above and go through the prior authorization process with Navitus
  - Coverage for GLP-1 medications for diabetes **will not** change.

# What's Changing in 2026 cont.

- Access Guidance Services (Manufacturer Copay Assistance)
  - **Mandatory** program for certain high-cost medications with manufacturer copay assistance available
    - Including some HIV, Specialty and GLP-1 medications
    - Late October mailing to impacted members
  - Navitus Access Team will assist members in enrolling in manufacturer copay assistance programs
  - Members pay the copay set by the manufacturer, instead of full cost of the medication
    - Only payments made by members will count toward out-of-pocket maximum or deductible
    - Amounts paid by manufacturers will **not** count toward out-of-pocket maximum or deductible

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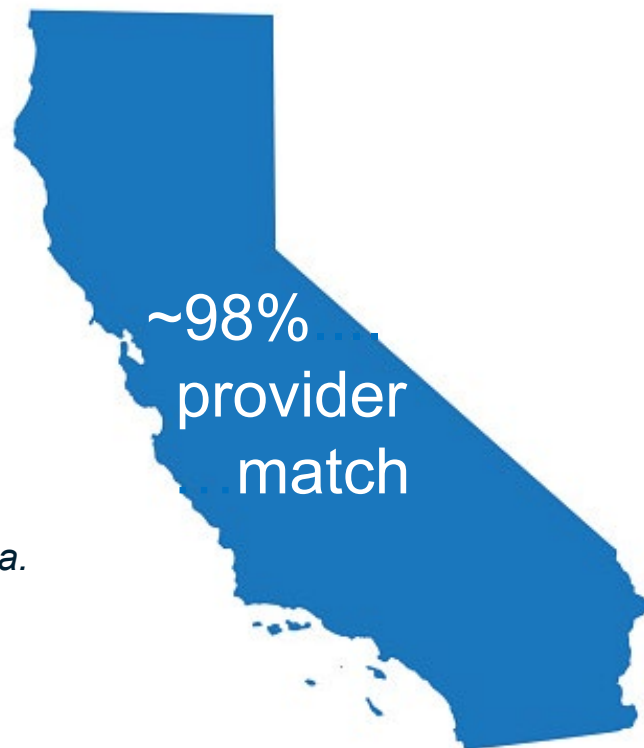

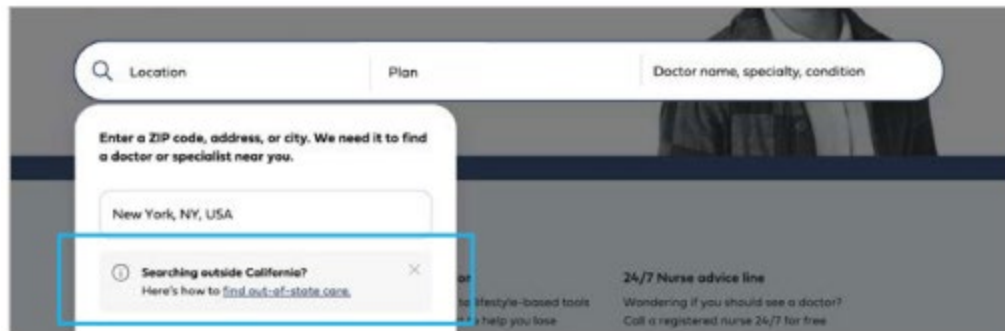

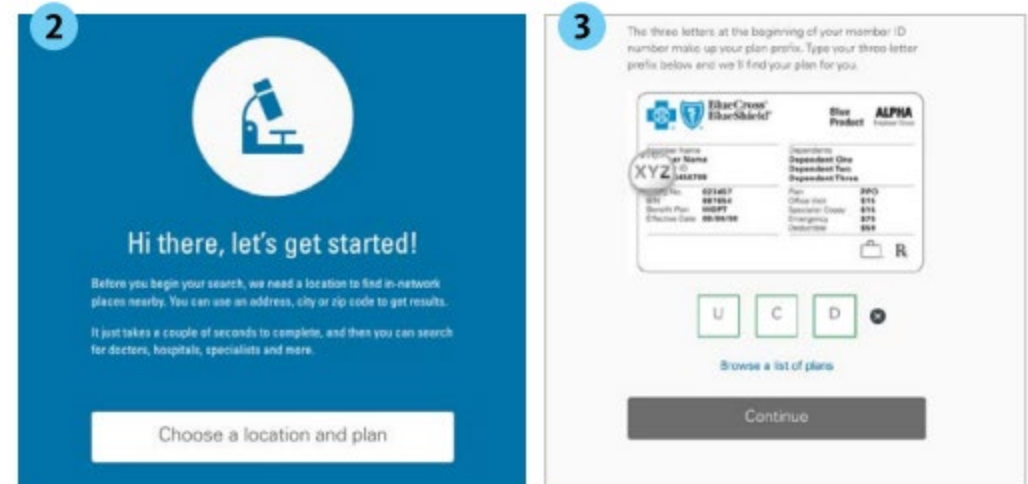

  - Members need to reach out to Global Core to obtain a Guarantee of Payment (GOP) before care is administered, or shortly after in Emergency situations
- **UC Care**- 20% coinsurance after deductible
- **HealthSavings+** - 30% coinsurance after deductible

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# Transition of Care (TOC)

Accolade will be transferring all existing Prior Authorizations and Gap Exception approvals to Blue Shield prior to January 1, 2026

- No action is required by you
- Approved Authorizations
  - » Automatic transfer of all approved authorizations
  - » Authorizations will be honored based on existing approvals
- Existing Gap Exceptions
  - » Automatic transfer to Blue Shield prior to 2026
  - » Members are required to renew all GAP exceptions
- Accolade is taking extra steps to notify anyone of open GAP exceptions

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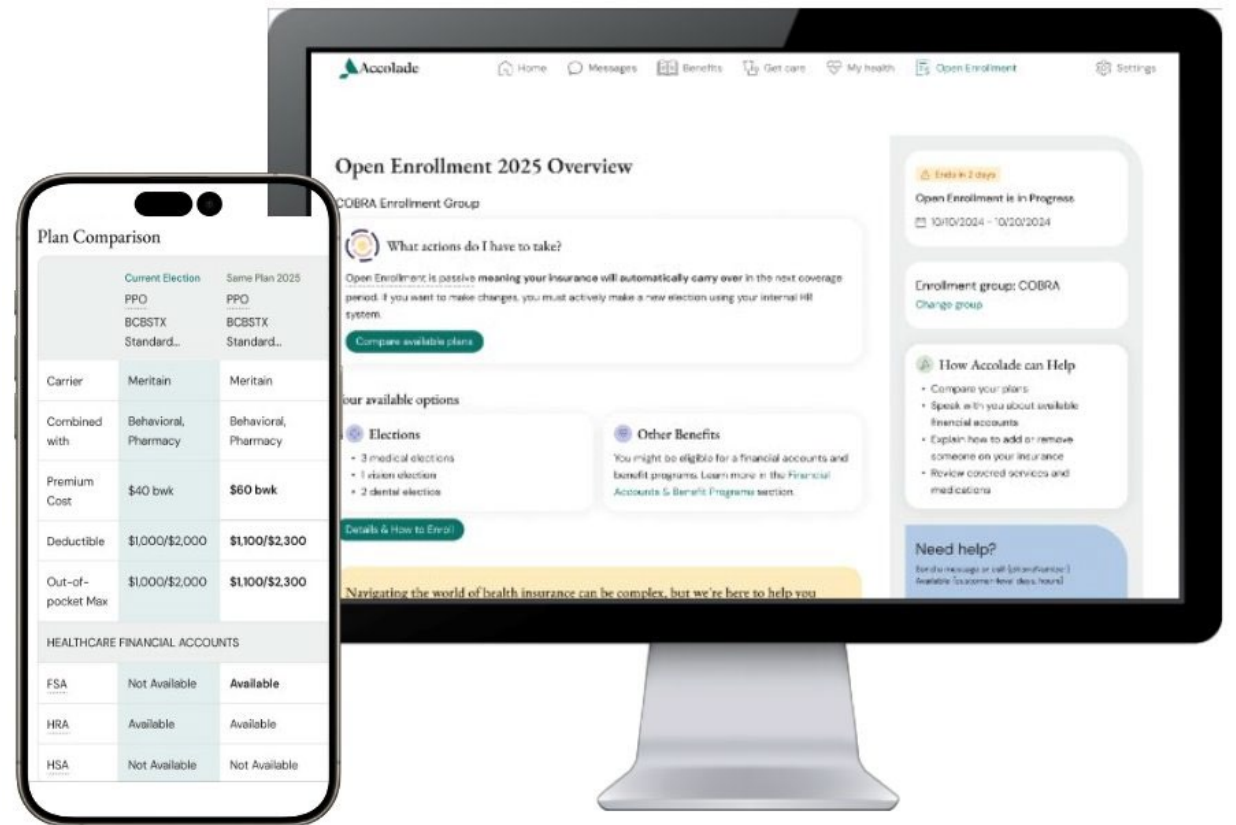

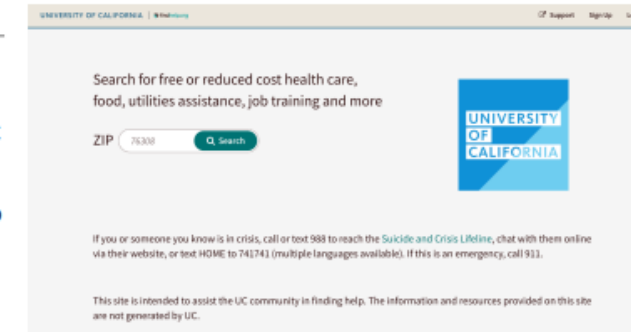


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## What you need to know

## What is findhelp

Findhelp is a social care network that connects people and programs, making it easier to find support and social services within your community. Findhelp connects you with resources that can help you find a job, access affordable food, receive medical care, and more — all in one place. Findhelp features more than 600,000 distinct program locations that help millions of people across the country.

## Who can use findhelp

Any UC health plan member or family member that needs support with their social, financial or physical health and wellbeing can use Findhelp. Findhelp's search platform lets you search for resources in your community with dignity and ease, and without restrictions or gatekeepers.

Findhelp can link you with a variety of services, including:

- **Food:** Find help to pay for food, locating food pantries, and seeking nutrition education
- **Housing:** Find advice and help on finding or paying for housing and locating temporary shelters

- **Education:** Find help paying for school, financial or health education; citizenship and immigration assistance; and skills and training

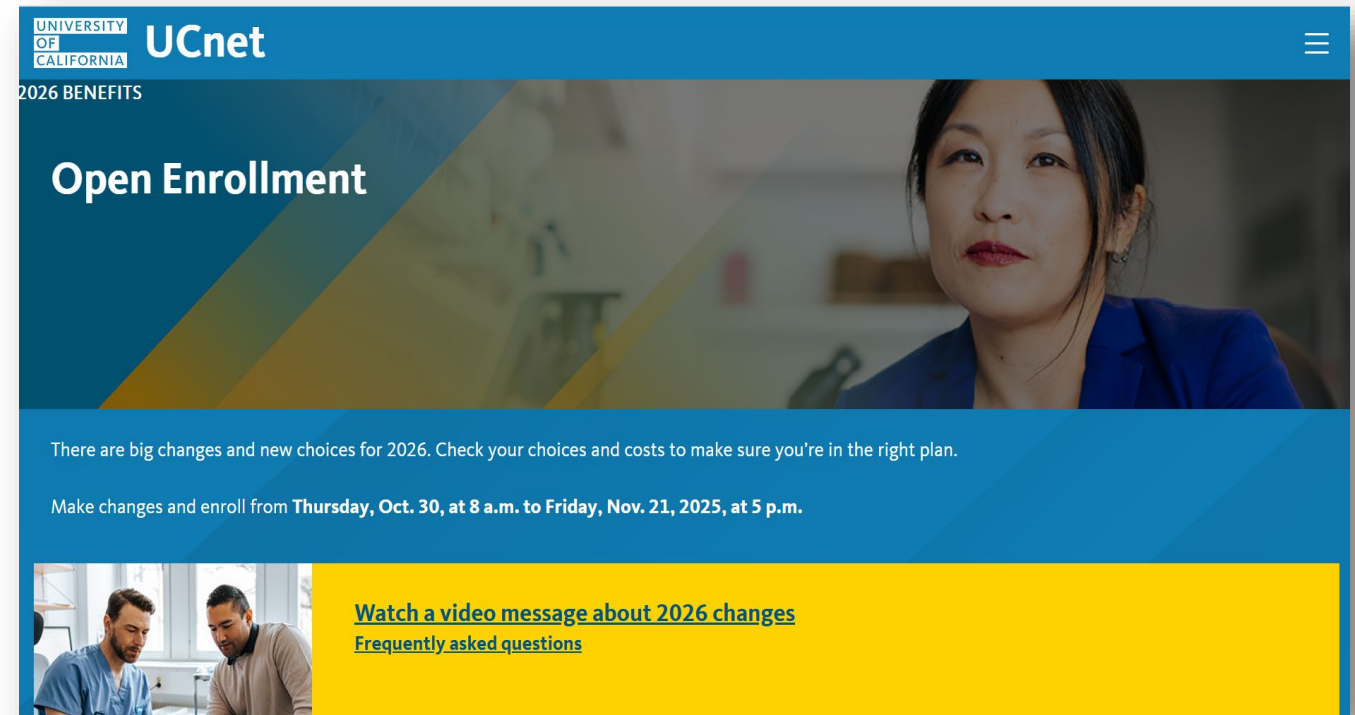
