California Fires: January 9, 2025

Eaton fire: Evacuations, school closures, shelters

The Eaton fire, which broke out Tuesday night near Eaton Canyon, has burned 10,600 acres in Altadena and Pasadena, spurring numerous evacuations. Arcadia and Sierra Madre also ordered evacuations in some of their northern neighborhoods.

Evacuations

- Most of Altadena was ordered evacuated, as was unincorporated Kinneloa Mesa. The mandatory evacuation area
 was expanded in Altadena to include areas west of Lake Avenue and north of Altadena Drive and generally the area
 north of Woodbury Road east of Windsor Avenue and west of Fair Oaks Avenue.
- In Pasadena, a mandatory evacuation order was in place in the northern half of the neighborhood of Hastings Ranch
 — north of Sierra Madre Boulevard. A mandatory evacuation order was downgraded to a warning elsewhere in
 Pasadena.
- Evacuation orders were also issued for eastern La Cañada Flintridge, including the Jet Propulsion Laboratory, according to the official evacuation map on the Genasys website.
- In Sierra Madre, mandatory evacuations were ordered north of Sierra Madre Boulevard, and voluntary evacuations were in place for the rest of the city.
- In Arcadia, mandatory evacuations were ordered north of Foothill Boulevard and east of Santa Anita Avenue, as well as north of Orange Grove Avenue and west of Santa Anita Avenue.
- The area of Glendale placed under a mandatory evacuation order is east of the 2 Freeway. By Thursday morning, some of those evacuations were beginning to lift. City officials notified residents in Glenoaks Canyon and Chevy Chase Canyon that it was safe to return to their homes.

Red Cross

"This is significant," Nowlin told ABC News. "It's not just the fire, but you've got wind damage, you've got power outages, you've got trees falling, deteriorating air quality. This is impacting thousands and thousands of folks in Los Angeles." The Red Cross provides emergency relief to residents and families impacted by disasters, providing meals, medical care and a safe place to shower and sleep.

Just as multiple wildfires are spreading through the Los Angeles area, several companies and organizations are offering free or discounted resources to help victims and their loved ones stay safe.

According to the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, the Palisades wildfire has destroyed at least 1,000 structures since Tuesday, making it the most destructive fire to ever occur in Los Angeles County.

Evacuation efforts have been repeatedly complicated by snarled traffic situations as masses of people attempt to flee on limited highway space and narrow roads. As I'm writing this story, there are thousands of Los Angeles residents who are being ordered to evacuate their homes as the California wildfires continue. The <u>Watch Duty app</u> has real-time information on the current blazes. As a pet owner, I wanted to compile information for anyone who has to evacuate with their pet—and for anima lovers who can offer support and help at this time.

Resources List for Animal Evacuations

- If you are in a situation where you need to leave without being able to take your pet with you, here is a <u>Google Docs</u> open list of local areas that are providing shelter to large animals, animal boarding, and detailed information.
- Travel curator <u>Kristen Fung posted on Threads</u> that several hotel chains will welcome pets. Per Fung's post,
 "Kimptons are the pet friendliest that allow more than one pet, no extra fees, or weight limits. The Ws will take more
 than one pet at a pet deposit and \$50 per day per pet Palisociety and Line hotels take one pet at a fee and weight
 limits." She also points out that large animals can be sheltered at the <u>Los Angeles Equestrian Center</u>.
- Nonprofit organization, <u>One Dane at a Time</u>, is offering to take in any animals—as well as a generous donor who has
 offered placement in her Pomona home. Reach out directly to the organization to coordinate. They are located away
 from the fires so they are a safe haven for pets right now.
- Per <u>Threads</u>, the pet hotel, <u>Four Paws One Tail</u>, can host and care for 20 more pets for free at the Four Paws 1 Tail in 8424 Haskell Ave, North Hills, CA 91343.
- If you are in need of pet supplies or need temporary shelter for your pets, you can reach out to the <u>Lange</u> <u>Foundation</u> at 2106 South Sepulveda Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90025.
- Mutual Aid LA has a running list on Instagram of animal rescue centers. Check out the comments in the post for specific rescue organizations offering to take in animals.
- <u>Leo's Animal Rescue in Kern County</u> (about two-and-half hours away from Los Angeles) is able to take in some animals as well.
- Brittany Cole Bush is offering to help haul horses and livestock to evacuate any of the fires in Los Angeles (you can send her a DM on Instagram).
- A local woman in Marina del Rey has offered temporary housing for pets at a former veterinary hospital. See the

What You Can Do to Help Animals in Need

Right now, several shelters are asking for anyone who can help foster and take in animals as they see an influx of animals coming in. If you can volunteer, offer space in your home, or donate, take the time to give to these organizations who are on the ground, taking in emergency cases.

Rescues & Shelters That Need Assistance Now

- The <u>Lange Foundation is asking for donations</u> for cat food, dog food, litter, and pet supplies. If anyone can help with temporary fostering right now, they are are asking you contact them at info@langefoundation.org.
- Philozoia Animal Rescue in Topanga is desperately seeking dog fosters as their ranch is on fire and the 30 dogs in their care need to be evacuated. Reach out if you can bring a dog into your home temporarily.
- Pasadena Humane Society. They have taken in over 100 animals so far. From the shelter, "We will accept animals for emergency boarding at our Animal Resource Center at 361 S. Raymond Avenue, Pasadena, 91105."
- If you find injured wildlife, text 626-344-1129 to pass along the information to PHS.
- PHS has asked for anyone who can take in a dog or cat to contact them. From the shelter, "We ask that anyone who can safely foster a dog or a cat for at least one week to please come to the Pasadena Humane Foster Office or email foster@pasadenahumane.org. Our greatest need is for large dog fosters."
- Drop off donations needed: food, water bowls, extra large crates, and blankets. Place into the donation bins located in the front underground parking lot.
- Monetary donations for wildfire relief for pets is needed.
