In the last year alone, incredible progress has been made toward these outcomes. However, there is still much important work to do. The recommendations from the Deloitte report serve as the drivers of Avanti.

Guided by the <u>ETHOS principles</u> and inspired by the spirit of "Avanti" (Italian for "to move forward" or "to advance"), the key objectives of this multi-year effort to transform HR are:
